WALLACE ISLAND CABINS



Wallace island has enjoyed a unique and interesting history. During one of its historical phases, the island was the site of a small resort owned by David Conover. The resort contained a cluster of approximately ten buildings that included some guest cottages, the Conover's residence, recreation hall and support buildings.

Four of these cabins and some small outbuildings have been removed due to their structural disrepair. Three cabins remain, including the original Conover's residence, to preserve a representation of the island's history and to accommodate a variety of park uses.
