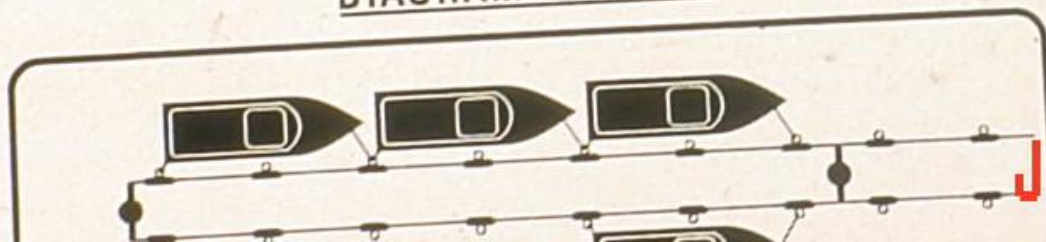
EAGLE HARBOR LINEAR MOORAGE

MAXIMUM CAPACITY:
TWELVE 30 FEET VESSELS OR EQUAL
(SEE DIAGRAM BELOW FOR CLARIFICATION OF USE.)

DEPOSIT:
DEPOSIT MOORING FEE IN BOX PROVIDED AT THE PUBLIC DOCK.

- RULES FOR USE:
1. USE MOORING RINGS ONLY, TO SECURE VESSEL TO SYSTEM. DO NOT TIE UP TO ROPES OR METAL COMPONENTS.
 2. USE BOTH, BOW AND STERN LINES, TO SECURE TO MOORING RINGS. TWO RINGS PER VESSEL.
 3. RAFTING IS NOT PERMITTED.
 4. ABSOLUTELY NO CLIMBING, HANGING OR SITTING ON, OR JUMPING OFF OF, ANY MOORING SYSTEM COMPONENTS.
 5. VESSELS WITH FREEBOARD LOWER THAN MOORING RINGS USE CAUTION.

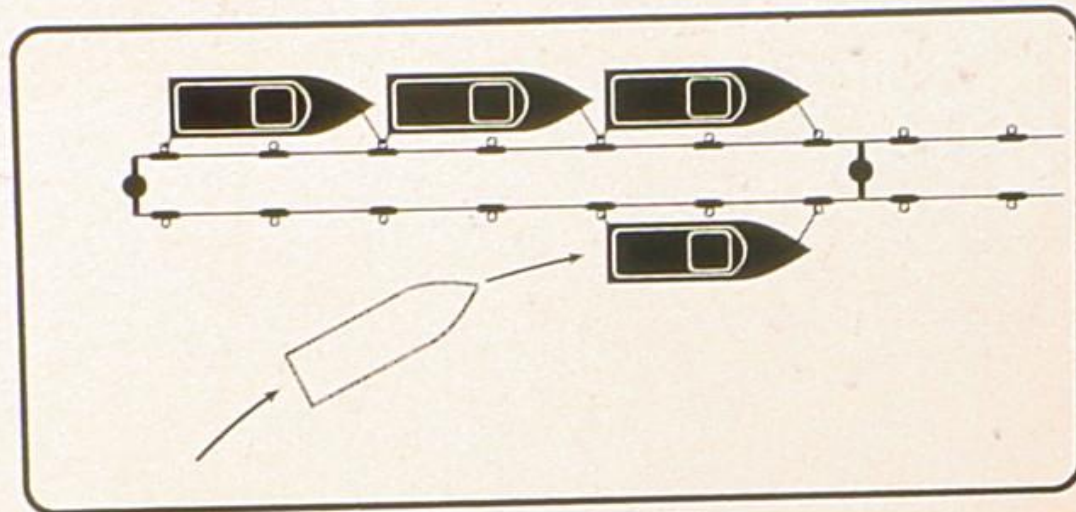
DIAGRAM FOR USE
